### Student Paper Presentation ABSTRACT Submission Guidelines

- 1. All Presenters should be registered members of the IPS and must have registered for the 5<sup>th</sup> IPS Kerala Conference during submission of the abstract.
- 2. Student is allowed to participate in only one out of the following events: Scientific Paper or E-Poster.
- 3. All the paper presentations are categorized as: original research, case report & review.
- 4. The presentations should adhere to the central theme of the conference: "Prosthodontics moving forward".
- 5. The structured abstract should be submitted not exceeding 250 words.

The abstract headings should be as follows:

- a. For original and secondary researches: Background, Methods, Results & Conclusions.

- 6. No tables, charts, or graphs shall be included in the abstract.
- 7. Presenters' first name, last name along with title of Scientific Paper, Institution, City and Contact details must be stated clearly in the abstract.
- 8. The abstract should not have been submitted or accepted at any other state, national or international scientific meeting.
- 9. Abstracts of the unfinished researches will not be accepted.
- 10. Abstracts with plagiarism will not be accepted.
- 11. File format of the abstract must be a **.pdf** file.

- Only E-submission is accepted.
   Hand written/ typed abstract and submission through fax will not be accepted.

### Student Paper Pre-Recorded Video Presentation Submission Guidelines

- 1. All Presenters should be registered members of the IPS and must have registered for the 5<sup>th</sup> IPS Kerala Conference during submission of the abstract.
- 2. Student is allowed to participate in only one out of the following events: Scientific Paper or E-Poster.
- 3. All the paper presentations are categorized as: original research, case report & review.
- 4. The presentations should adhere to the central theme of the conference: "Prosthodontics moving forward".
- 5. Presentation must be a pre-recorded video in .mp4 format of a HD resolution of minimum 720p in 4:3 OR 16:9 ratio format. The presenter and the presentation must be visible throughout the presentation. The file size of the Pre-Recorded Scientific Paper Presentation Video must not exceed 1 GB.
- 6. Title of Scientific Paper along with Presenters' names, Institution, City must be legibly present on the **Title slide** of the Presentation. No names of guiding staff should be mentioned in the presentation.
  - Mention of any such names would amount to disqualification of the Scientific Paper Presentation.
- 7. Duration of each *pre-recorded* Scientific Paper Presentation should not exceed 8 minutes. This will be followed by a **2-minute live discussion**, the schedule of which will be informed in advance.

## **Student E-Poster Presentation Submission Guidelines**

- 2. Student is allowed to participate in only one out of the following events: Scientific Paper or E-Poster.
- 3. All the poster presentations are categorized as: original research, case report or review.
- 4. The presentations should adhere to the central theme of the conference in Prosthodontics: "Prosthodontics moving forward".
- 5. The Scientific Poster must be prepared in **landscape** orientation.
- 6. The poster should have a clear structure and layout with minimum amount of text.
- 7. The Scientific Poster Presentation must be a video file in .mp4 format of a HD resolution of minimum 720p in 4:3 OR 16:9 ratio format. The presenter and the poster must be visible throughout the presentation. The file size of the Pre-Recorded Scientific Poster Presentation Video must not exceed 500MB.
- 8. Title of Scientific Poster along with Presenters' names, Institution, City must be legibly present on the Poster. No names of guiding staff should be mentioned in the presentation.

  Mention of any such names would amount to disqualification of the Scientific Paper Presentation.
- 9. Duration of each *pre-recorded* Scientific Poster Presentation should not exceed **3 minutes**. This will be followed by a **2-minute live discussion**, the schedule of which will be informed in advance.
- 10. **Both** the presenters should be registered and should be **present** at the time of their poster presentation and subsequent discussion.
- 11. Pre-Recorded Scientific Poster Presentation Video must be **uploaded** to your **Google Drive** and shared with **poster**.ipskcon@gmail.com as **Editor**.
- 23. Last date for submission of Pre-Recorded Scientific Poster Presentation Video is **25**<sup>th</sup> **April 2022.**
- 12. The maximum number of participants is restricted to 2 students per poster presentation. Second presenter will be considered as Co-author. Presentation must be done by main author only.
